



# MOUNTAINS

As on Earth, mountains are simply huge landforms that stretch above the surrounding land in a limited area forming a peak. Mountains are generally steeper than hills and with few exceptions a minimum of one thousand feet in height and of an average slope of at least two degrees. Beyond that, there are many different types of mountain just like on Earth and can be the result of plate collisions, volcanic eruptions, magma domes, eroded plateaus, etc

Mount Cathedraas	White Mountains	Tallest Mountain on Al'Akwannon, 30,000 feet tall
Mount Dwimorberg	White Mountains	Infamous for being the Haunted Mountain, Malchoss' former seat
Mount Enlibar	Ashwind Mountains	Famous for iron ore which creates exceptional steel, Enlibarian Steel
Mount Methedraas	White Mountains	Second Tallest Mountain on Al'Akwannon, 29,458 feet tall
Mount Nuage	Mountains of Death	Most active volcano in the Sunken Sea region, constant plume of smoke
Mount Platine	Platinum Mountains	Tallest and largest mountain in the Platinum range, huge platinum vein
Mount Silverlode	N/A	Largest free standing mountain in Central Al'Akwannon, Dwarven Kingdom
