



# RIVERS OF AL'AKWANNON

As with any earth-like world, rivers on Al'Akwannon are made up of confluences of headstreams regardless of their source which combine and become rather large. The definition of a river is one which is navigable by some sort of craft (a canoe at the least) and is thus termed a waterway of some sort. Creeks, streams, brooks and any other flowing bit of fresh water are generally non-navigable for any significant stretch due to difficult terrain, lack of water flow, etc. Some major rivers are listed below:

## RIVERS OVER 2000 MOUTH DRAINAGE AREA (Massive via Volume)

- River Zaron** – a massive river in the western Sunken Sea Region that connects the Sunken Sea with the Rune Sea and is a major trade route between Morgana and Hippocrane
- Rogue River** – a massive river in the southern Sunken Sea Region that flows from the Sunken Sea to the Rune Sea and is a major trade route between Hippocrane and various Sunken Sea cities
- Caerbaelg River** – a major river in the Far West Region that serves as the border between Ostenaar and the Dark Marche and flows into the Veridiaan Strait
- the Hedemarke** – a major river in Kaltesvard that flows from the Skarstind mountains to the ocean at Gondheim

## RIVERS OVER 2000 MILES IN LENGTH

- River Eridaun** – a major river in the Far West Region that serves as the northern border to the country of Eridaun north of Rohan
- Fear'Bolgah River** – a major river in the Far West Region that mostly divides the northern two thirds of the region and forms the eastern border of the Principalities of Armaegh
- Renalva River** – a major river in the Western Great North that creates part of the border between Kaltesvard and Pheralon

Should be about 20 of these

## FAMOUS RIVERS DUE TO LOCATION

- Cinnabar River** – a major river in the eastern Sunken Sea Region that flows through the great city of Isengrim
- Enlibar River** – a major river in the eastern Sunken Sea Region that flows through the great city of Cirdan
